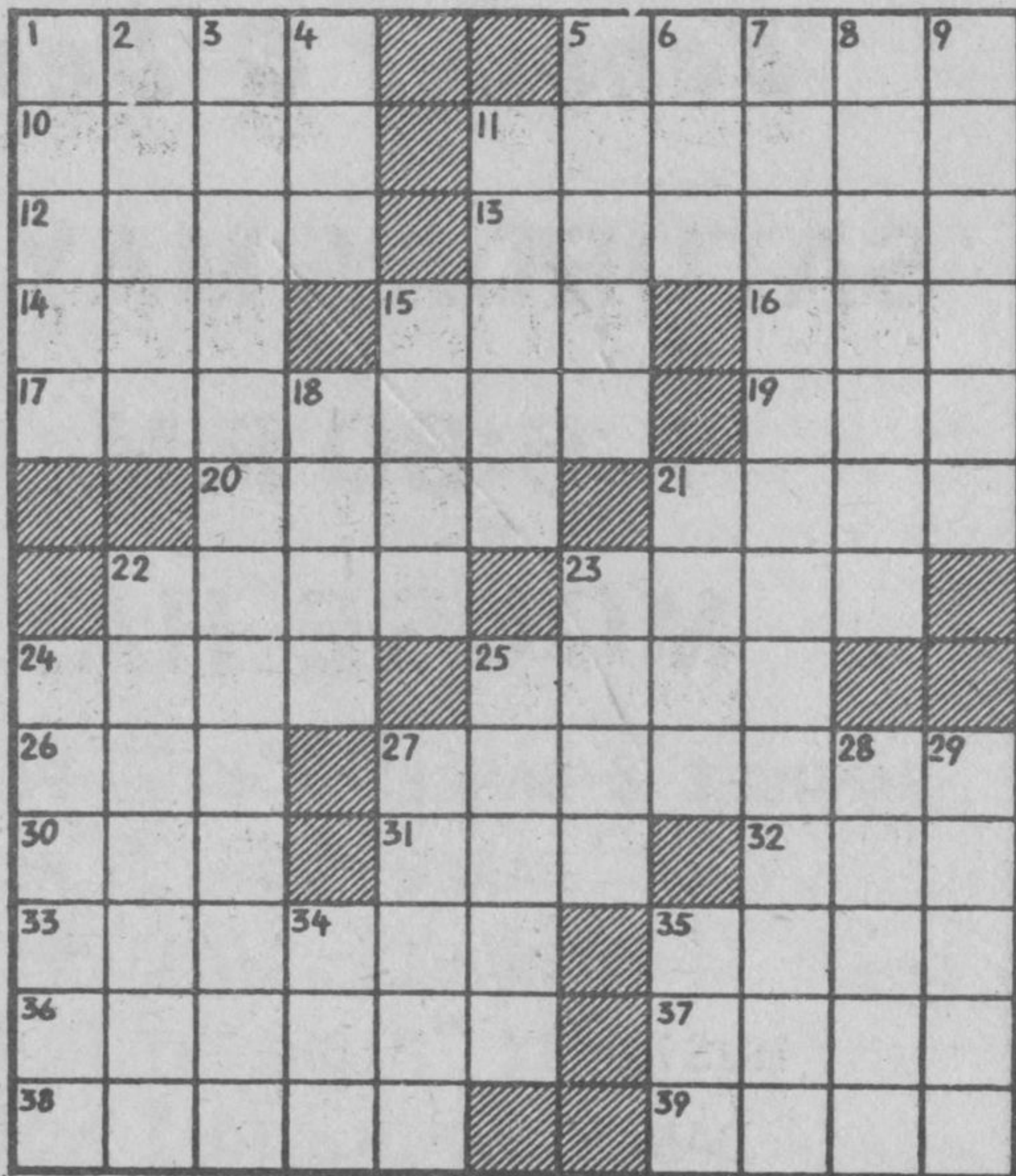
CROSSWORD PUZZLE
