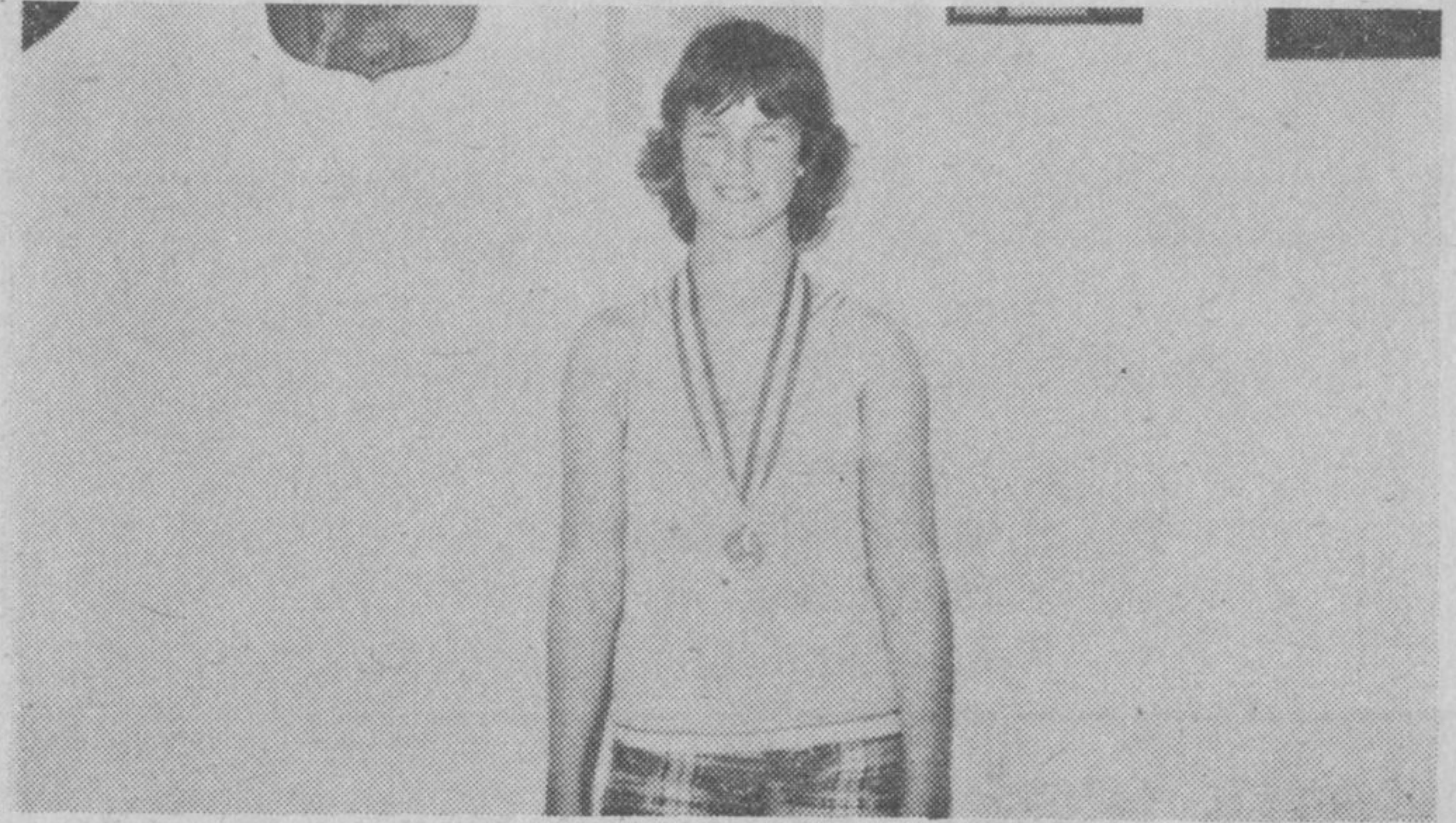
TRACK AND FIELD COMPETITION
