Mrs. Rena McAdam, president of the McCausland Hospital Board of Governors, was the guest speaker at the regular June meeting of the Schreiber Women's Institute on June 11th.

She described the early history of the hospital in Terrace Bay, the duties and objectives of the Board of Governors, to make the present building an efficient and pleasant place for Schreiber and Terrace Bay patients, despite present problems and outlined plans for a new health facility.
