The name of Mr. Brian Paulsen was erroneously omitted from last week's graduation write-up. Brian was the recipient of a \$50. award from the Women of the Moose.

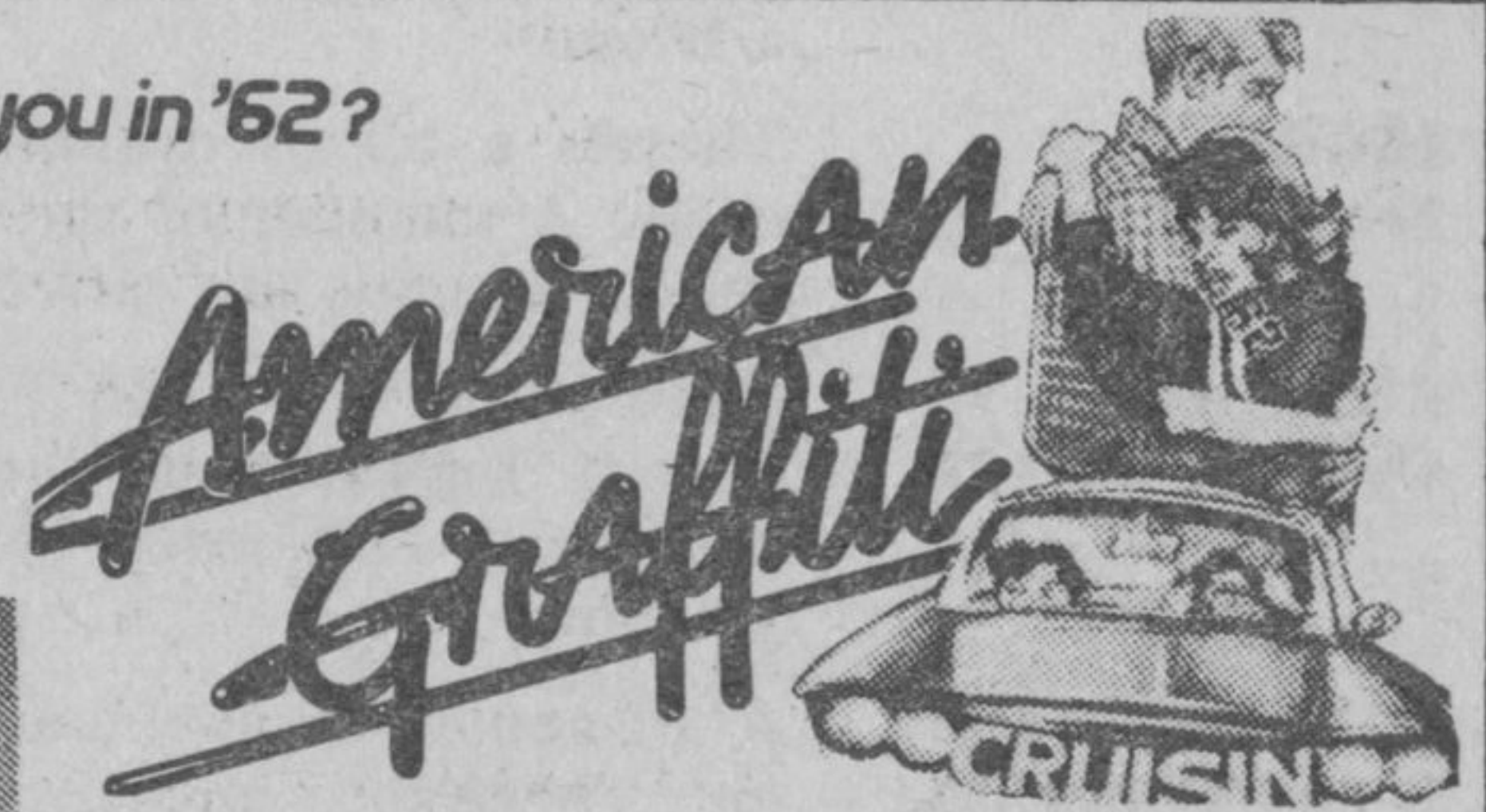
