- 3. Make arrangements to have your lawn mowed and shubbery trimmed if you are on an extended vacation;
- 4. Have the person who is checking your residence alternate lighting arrangements within your home;
- 5. Suggest they park their car in your driveway while you are absent;
- 6. Make certain all windows and doors are lock -ed as well as the garage;
- 7. Place all "burgular assists" (ladders, tools, large boxes) away before leaving;
- 8. Don't let it be too well known of your impending absence;
- 9. Don't give your home an "empty look" by closing blinds or drapes, which are not normally closed for extended periods of time;
  10. Notify the police of your absence and when you expect to return so officers patrolling your street can also check your home.


