installed in Birchwood Terrace, led to a lengthy discussion. This matter will be discussed at a further meeting between store owners, Kimberly-Clark and the Fire Department, to try and come up with a better location for the alarm system.

The Medical Office of Health, Dr. Jane Pickersgill and staff advised they will be in Terrace Bay on September 9th, and will meet with members of council or interested persons to discuss matters of the Health Unit.

The Building Inspector's report was read. Notice of a meeting of the Thunder Bay District Municipal League to be held August 16th was read.

A letter from a member of the Bowling League regarding increased memberships was discussed, with the Council standing firmly behind the Recreation Committee, who feel the increase is justified.

Accounts passed for payment were: Township - \$271,407.46; Hydro \$14,893.16; Library \$666.48 Recreation \$26,073.22.

In reply to the tender for painting the exterior and trim on the Municipal Building, the contract was awarded to Nick Chopty.

The contract for paving the tennis court and the entrance to Norwood Motel was awarded to T and B Paving Company.

A letter from Kimberly-Clark requested consent to subdivide Lot 570 Lakeview Drive, providing a half lot to owners on either side. This again led to a lengthy discussion on the policy of subdividing lots. This matter will be brought to the Planning Board for a final decision.

A recommendation from Police Chief Barnett that Constable George Aulenback be raised from third class to second class constable was approved.
