Hospital claims are paid on a per diem rate. This rate varies among hospitals.

If you should require services in Canada the hospitals will forward your claim to OHIP. However, you could be required to pay the medical fee and claim reimbursement from OHIP.

When travelling in the United States medical claims incurred are paid at the rate of 90% of the Ontario Medical Fee Schedule. Many U.S. services are charged at a rate higher than the Ontario rates. When reimbursed one might think that OHIP has not paid the proper amount. Let me clarify this. OHIP is paying the claim at the rate of 90% of the O.M.A. Fee Schedule not 90% of the amount of the bill.

Hospital claims in the U.S. are paid in U.S. funds direct to the hospital. Since not all U.S. hospitals are familiar with OHIP it may be necessary to pay the account and be reimbursed from OHIP.

Should you require emergency treatment, OHIP hospital claims will pay the claim at the rate of 100% of the per diem rate. However if you elect to be hospitalized the claim will be paid at the rate of 75% of the per diem rate and 75% of the insured services fee.
