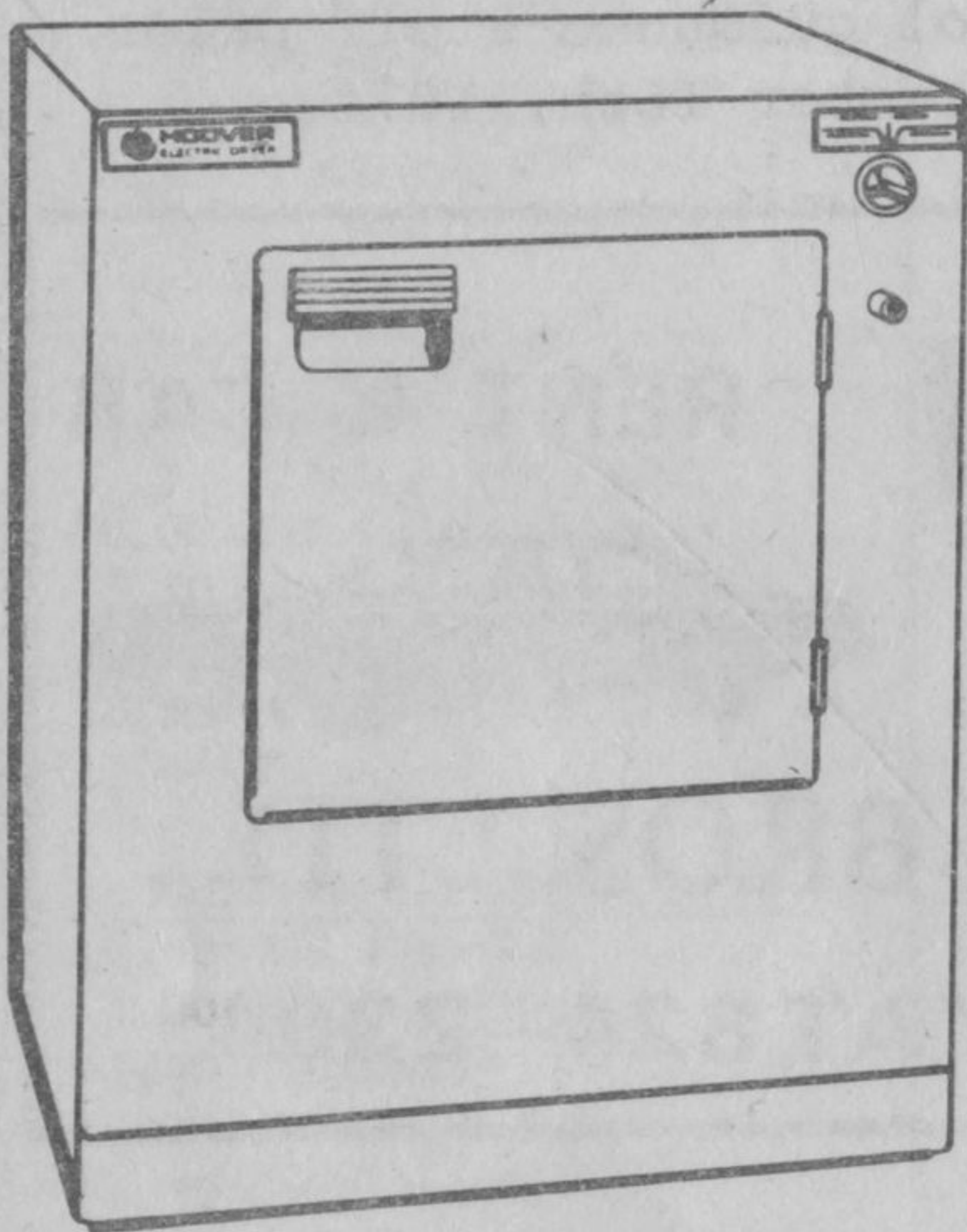

Construction costs for the recently begun Alaska pipeline project are expected to exceed two billion dollars. This represents the most expensive privately funded project in history.

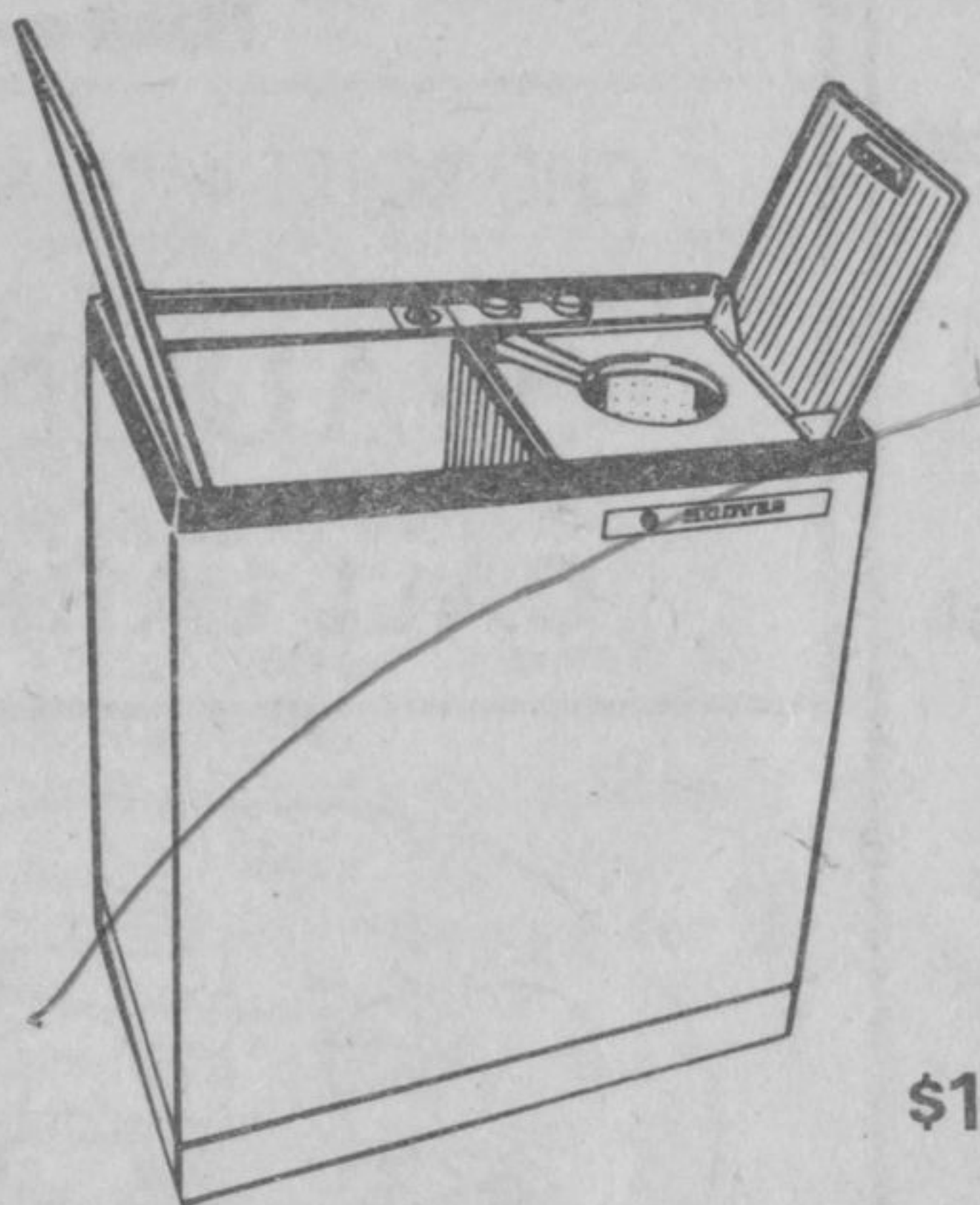


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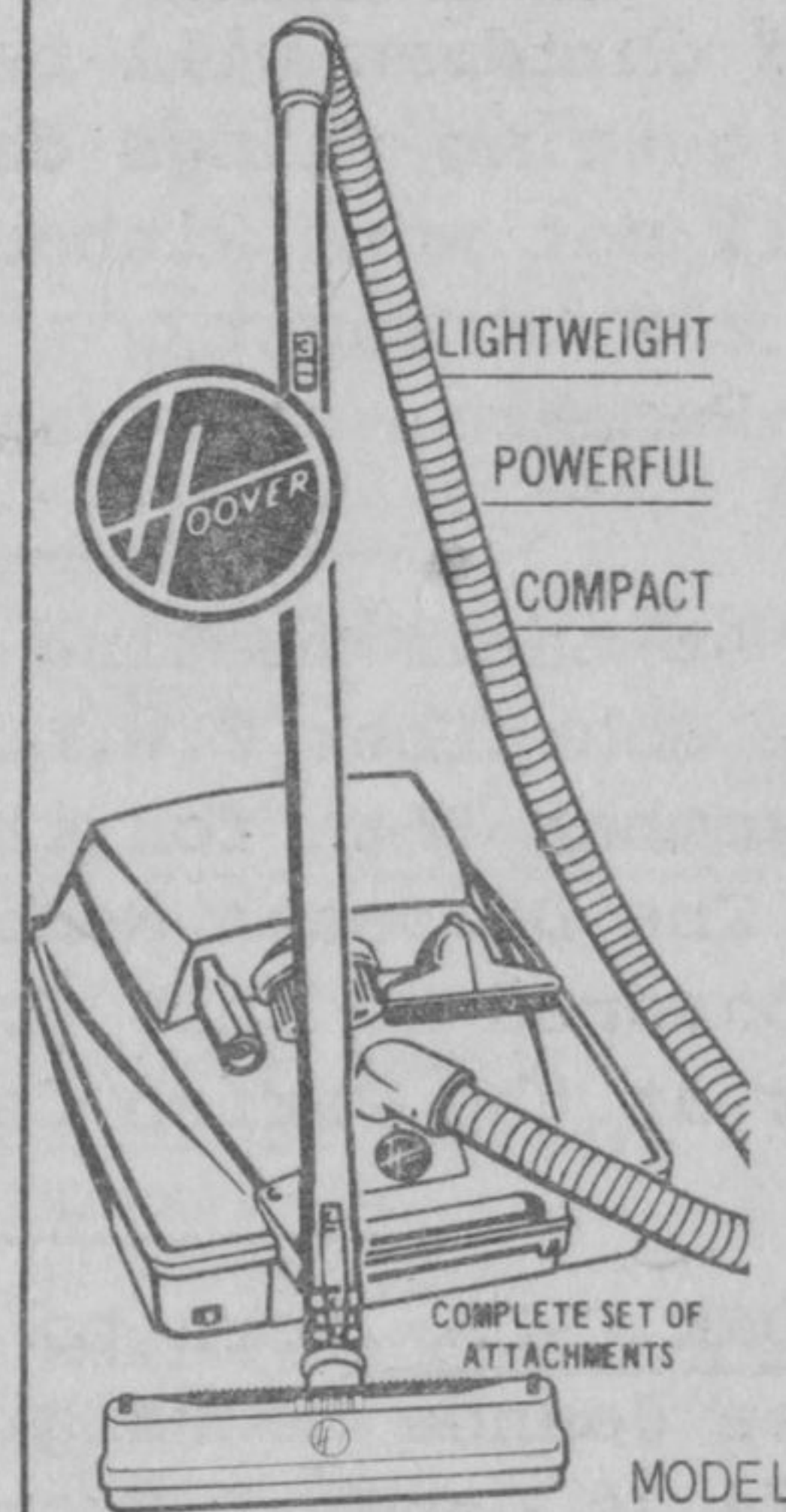


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
