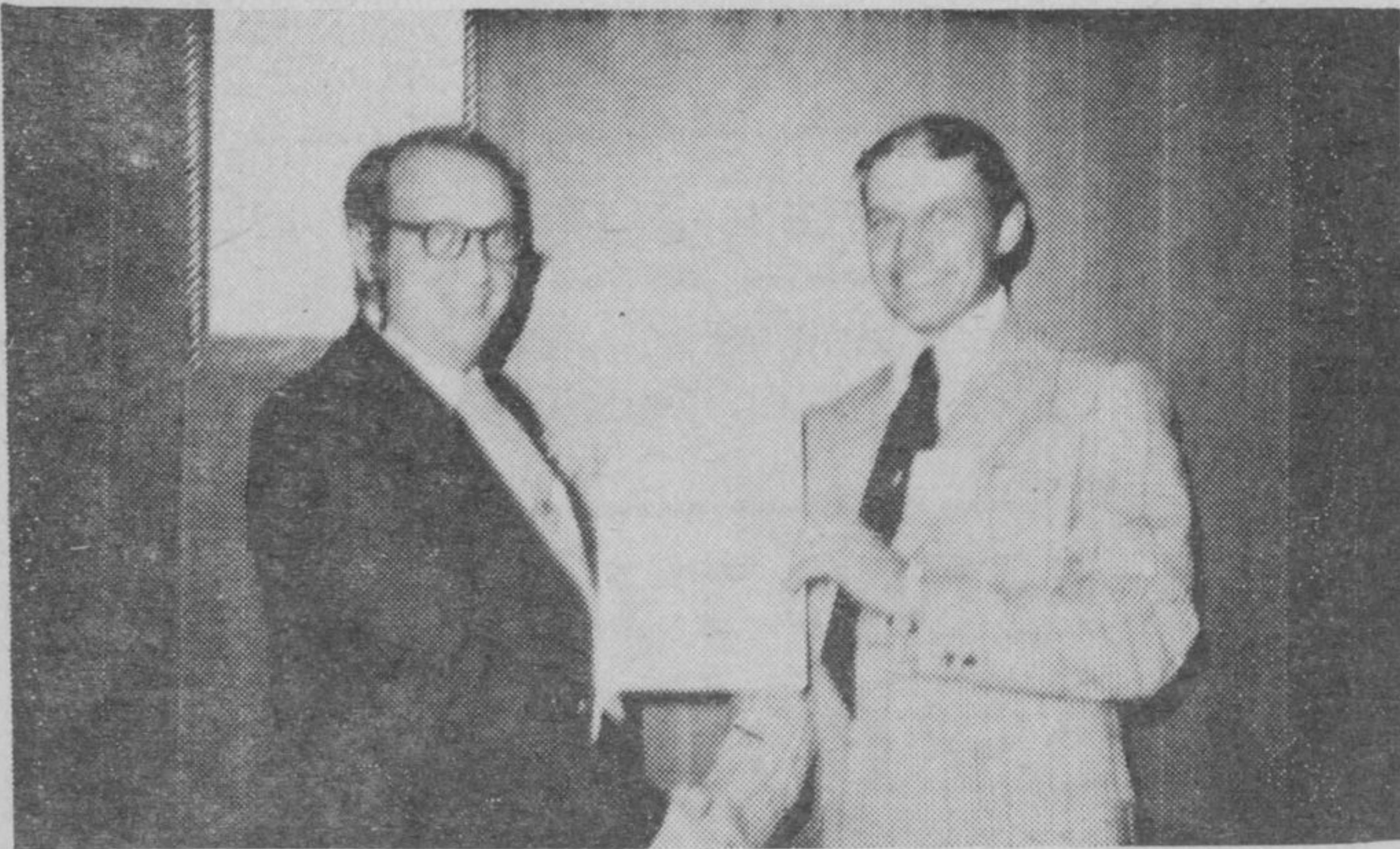

Until such a time as sufficient leadership is available the CUB PACK and SCOUT TROOP will not be meeting.

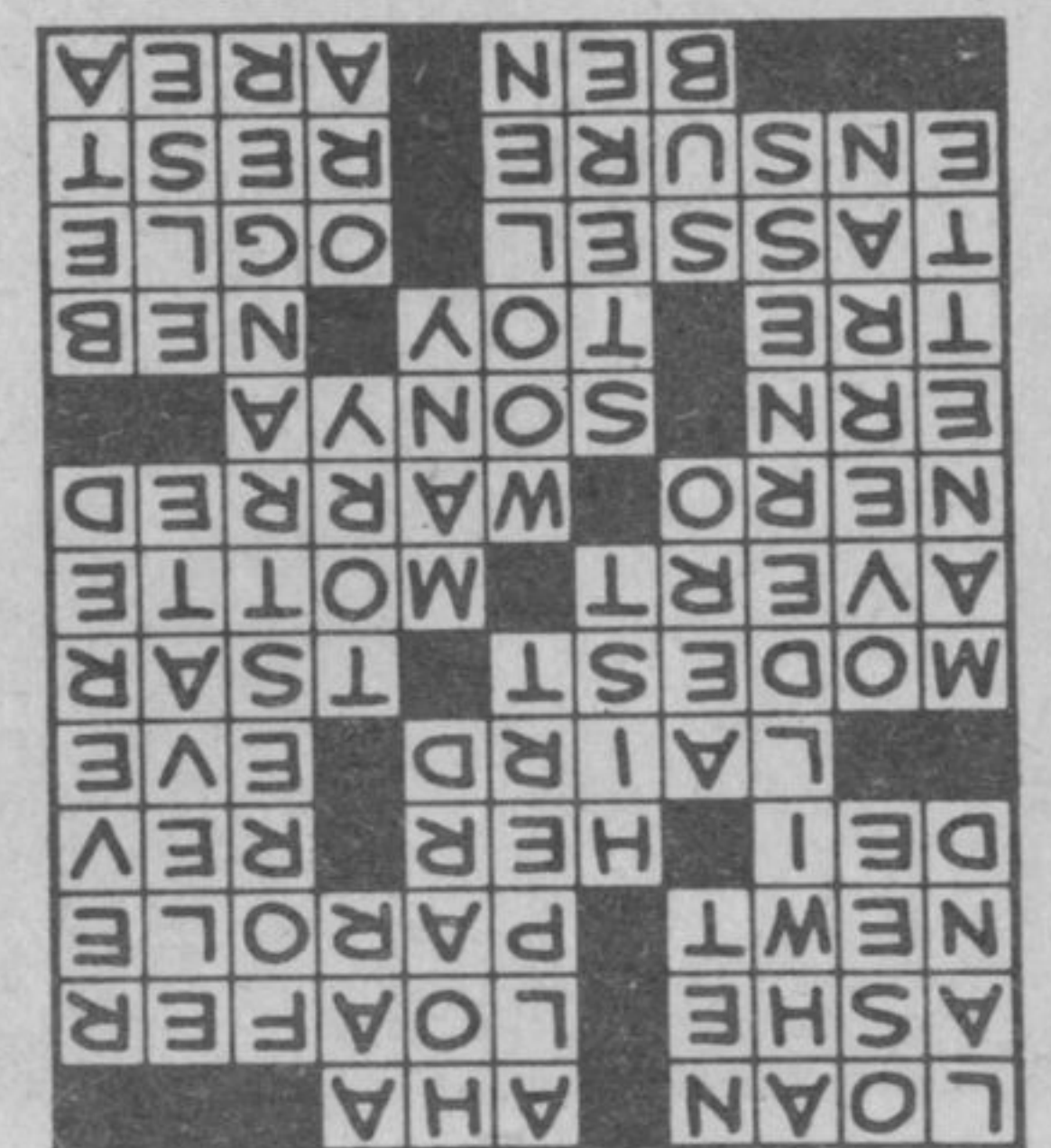
Parental interest and support must also be forthcoming if there is going to be a Scouting Program locally.
