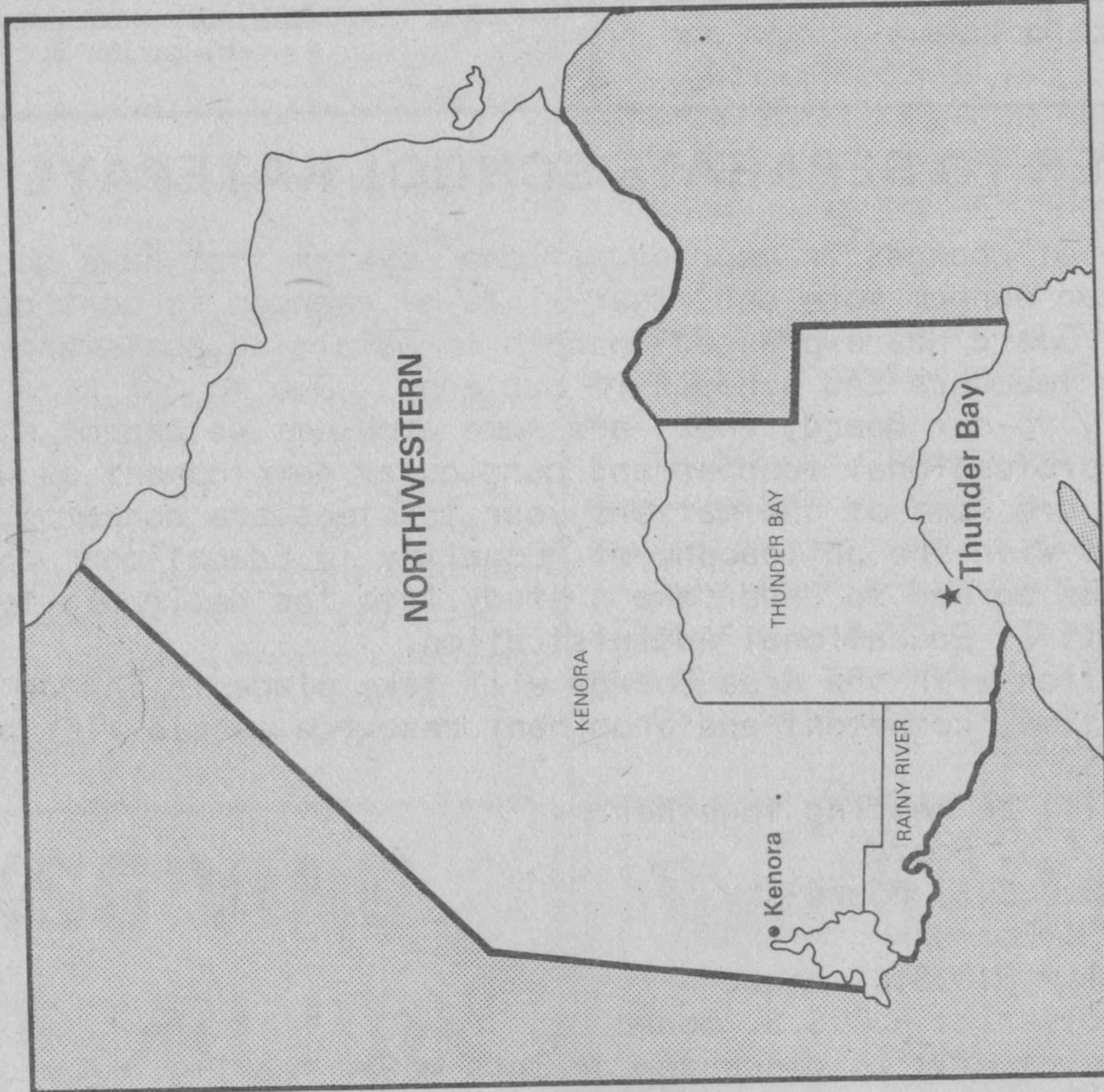


# Environment Ontario goes local.
