considerable number of extended care beds in the Terrace Bay area; either provided by a private nursing home or a wing on the new hospital and he felt this should be investigated by their committee and the Department of Health in their plans.

Accounts totalling \$16,992.86 were passed on the Mechanical and Electrical contracts. The contracted work has now been completed except for a deficiency list and necessary money to finish this work is being withheld by the Management Contractors, Barnett-McQueen.

A revision in the salary schedules for employees of both Pinewood Court and Birchwood Terrace have been approved effective January 1st, 1975.

Two local Terrace Bay people were successful in their tenders - subject to approval by the Ministry. Adamo's Radio & T.V. will supply the R.C.A. color TV at \$619.96. Sadowick Heating & Refrigeration will do the conversion of the cooler to a freezer at Birchwood Terrace.

There was considerable time spent on the "Report to the Board" put out by the Administrator.

Confirming the Minister's statement at the

convention in September, a memorandum was received from the Director, Mr. H. Sohn, advising that all terms of District Board Members have been extended until March 31st, 1975. This will allow the Ministry time to complete the Regulations pertaining to new appointments effective April 1st, 1975.

The present board will have the responsibility of developing a budget for 1975. There were a number of suggestions and recommendations that require attention to improve the quality of life in the homes. The first and major item would be an on-going plan that would convert the present four-to-a-room bedroom as in Pinewood to singles and doubles. This has been proposed by our residents' council and the board is aware of the existing problems with four persons per room.

After discussing the report, the board decided to request the attendance of Ranta and Tett at their next meeting to review the recommendations made about changes in the homes.

In regards to the extension of services into the community, it was thought that the municipalities should be informed and their opinions reviewed prior to launching the programme.
