Board of Education Meeting - continued

The Board will engage a consultant to prepare sketch plans and cost estimate for the proposed conversion of Apartment Building 2, Elementary, in Manitouwadge.

The Chairman of the Board will be paid the maximum allowed effective January 1, 1975.

The Board went into a Committee of the Whole Board and reported: (a) The acceptance, with regret, of the resignation of Terrace Bay Public School Trustee, B.G. Rapke effective November 1, 1974. (b) A contract settlement with the Elementary Teachers for the year 74-75. (c) Rental rates for 1975-76 will be increased. Tenants will be advised by mid-January of the new rates.

The Board accepted the offer by the Marathon Association for the Trainable Retarded to provide meals for the 74-75 winter meetings.

The next regular meeting of the Board will be held at Marathon High School, at 10:00 a.m., on Saturday, December 14th, 1974.

ATTENTION SNOWMOBILERS

The members of this O.P.P. Detachment have stopped a number of snow-machine operators and the essential credentials required, such as, driver's licence, insurance, if operated on a highway and the registration for the snow-machine have not been produced at the time.

Some operators are running their machines with an expired licence plate. The plates ran out on October 31st, 1974 and new plates are to be purchased before the machines can be operated on or off a highway. If you are operating your machine on private property or strictly bush trails, you are required, by law, to register them by means of a current year licence plate. If you plan on using them on the streets in town, Schreiber or Terrace Bay, you are required, by law, to produce when stopped by a Police Officer: (a) valid driver's licence (b) registration of snow-machine (licence plate no.), (c) insurance. Failure to comply with any or all of the above will lead to charges being laid under the Motorized Snow Vehicle Act of Ontario.
