"There will also be facilities for medical specialists from Thunder Bay who will be available for consultations locally as well as inservice training programs", said Mrs. McAdam.

In making the announcement on behalf of Kimberly-Clark, Mr. Puttock said the company hoped its contribution of up to \$100,000 would provide "the incentive for individuals and other businesses in Terrace Bay and Schreiber to support the building fund of the new hospital, which will be a magnificent asset to

the entire community."

Kimberly-Clark began operations at Terrace Bay in I948 when a model community was developed out of the wilderness on the north shore of Lake Superior. The company and the community have grown together since then.

The company recently announced plans for a major addition to its bleached kraft pulp manufacturing facilities at Terrace Bay, where it also operates a stud mill and carries out woodlands operations.
