Stork Club Congradulations this week go to Mr. and Mrs. Jerry Papousek on the birth of a son on December 17th.

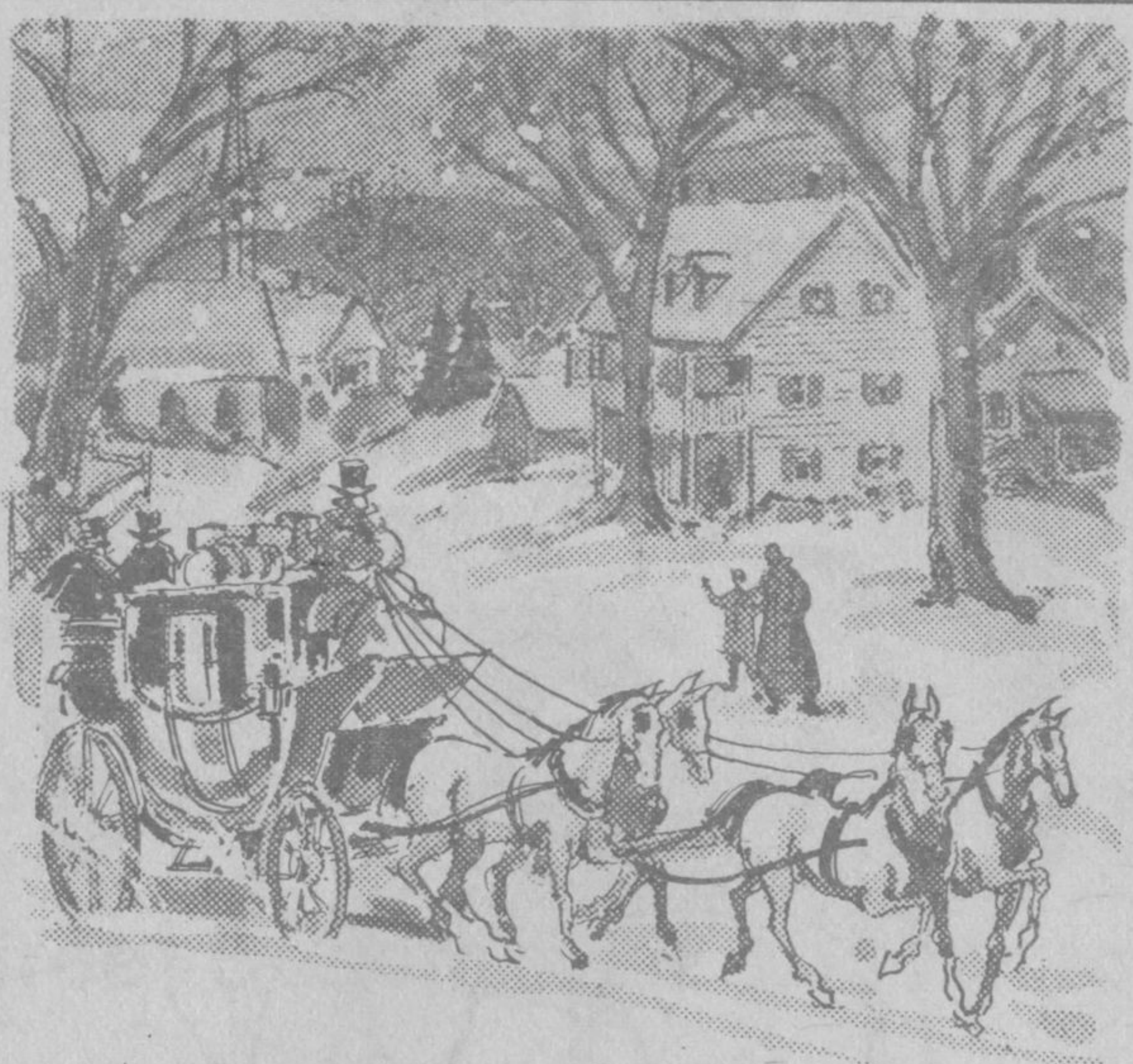
