Bill Stefurak won the draw for the biggest end.

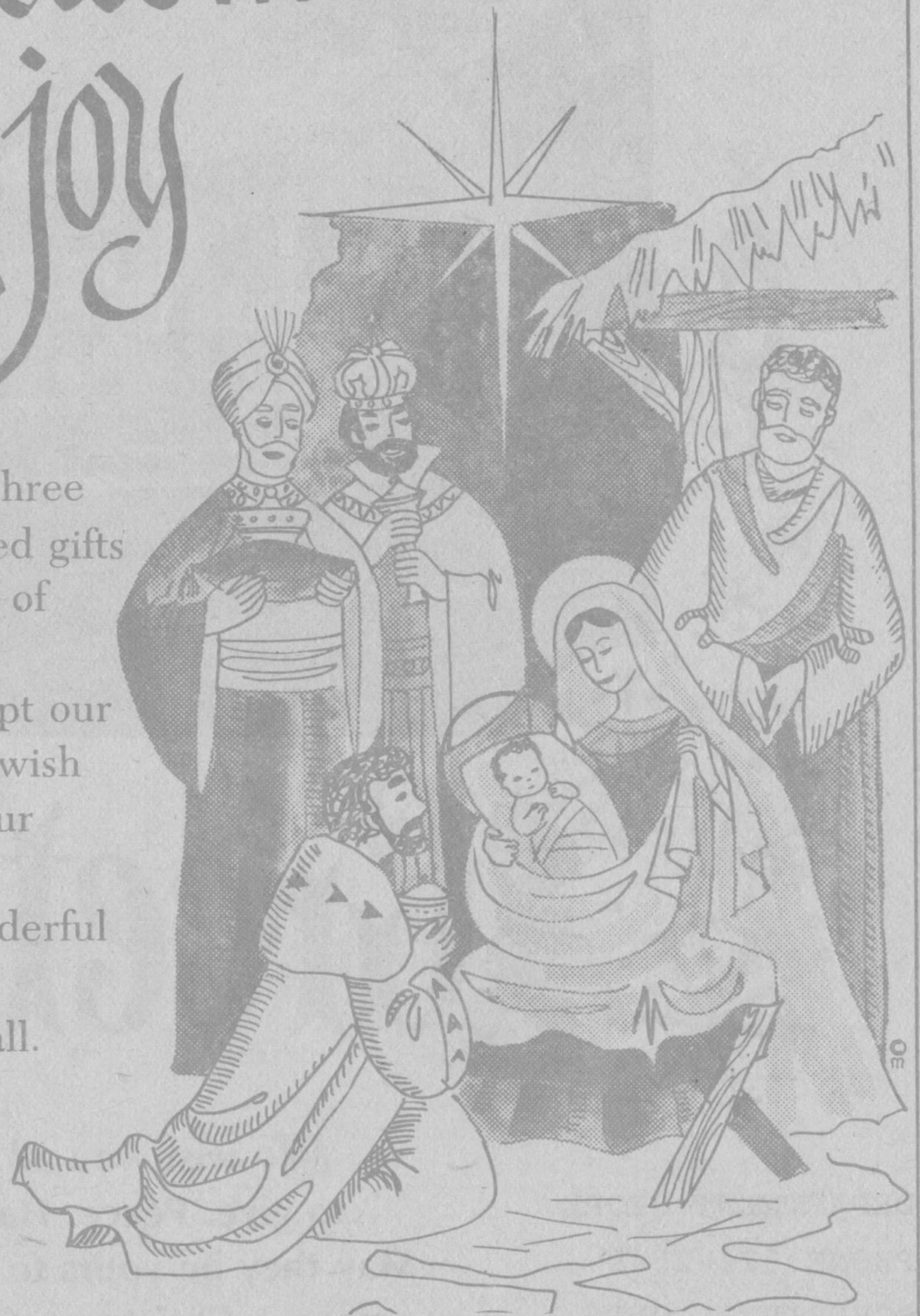
