the stove is installed, the big chore to keep it supplied with fuelwood. Fuelwood on Crown lands in Ontario is necessary to obtain a District Cutting License. This can be easily obtained from the District Office of the Ministry. The charge of a license is \$1.25 per cord.

Best time to cut firewood is during the winter months when cutting areas are accessible. More important, once the wood is cut, split and piled, it will have a chance to dry out properly before use and this will give you maximum heating value. You should also have some knowledge of the characteristics of the various species of wood used in this area. In general the softwood coniferous species are lighter wood, start to burn and burn faster than the hardwood or deciduous species. Cedar and spruce when split make excellent kindling. Fir burns slower. Tamarack (larch) is not available here, but if you can find it, has good long lasting qualities for a coniferous species. Birch is the only good hardwood fuelwood in the Boreal forests. The wood is dense and heavy with good heating value, throws a lot of heat for a long time.

So, if you enjoy the sound of a crackling woodstove and the glow of heat cast from it, why not put one on your shopping list for the next cold season? The exercise and enjoyment derived from building up your woodpile will be an added benefit.
