Letter from B. McCracken, Chairman of the Committee asked council to meet with vital board and the Township of Schreiber January 28th.

Letter from the Chief Election Office Council the liquor vote results had received and would be published in the Gazette.

Letter from the Ministry of Transportation Communications acknowledged Council's of October re future paving requirements. The paving program is now set for 1976. Ministry requested areas requiring be checked this summer.

Questionnaire from the Ministry of Housing proposed subdivision, part of J.K. 300 Plan) was completed. Also the draft approval and the conditions of the subdivision was also received from Ministry.

Council accepted with regret the resignation of W.R. Kilbey, effective January 30th,

December Police report was read. On nomination of Police Chief Barnett, Constable Pope was promoted to 2nd class constable.

McMurty Report (re violence in hockey) received from the Ministry of Community and will be passed on to the Recreation

tion Committee.

Pinewood Court submitted the township's portion of the actual heating cost for 1974 and it was noted this cost was lower than estimated.

A letter from the Hon. John Rhodes outlined the changes that will be made on the curve at Schreiber at the earliest possible date, but completion date will depend on when electrical power can be made available. The changes are as follows:

- 1. An identification sign for the Community of Schreiber will be relocated to the east side of the curve so that motorists will have an advance warning that they are entering a community.
- 2. An additional curve warning sign with an advisory speed tab will be posted on the left shoulder for the westbound traffic approaching the curve. The existing curve warning sign on the right shoulder will be increased in size to 48" x 48" and two amber alternating flashers (vertical) added to the sign for greater visual impact. A sign light will be installed over an enlarged 45 m.p.h. advisory speed limit sign.
- 3. A sign light will also be installed on the existing checkerboard presently in position on the outside of the curve.
