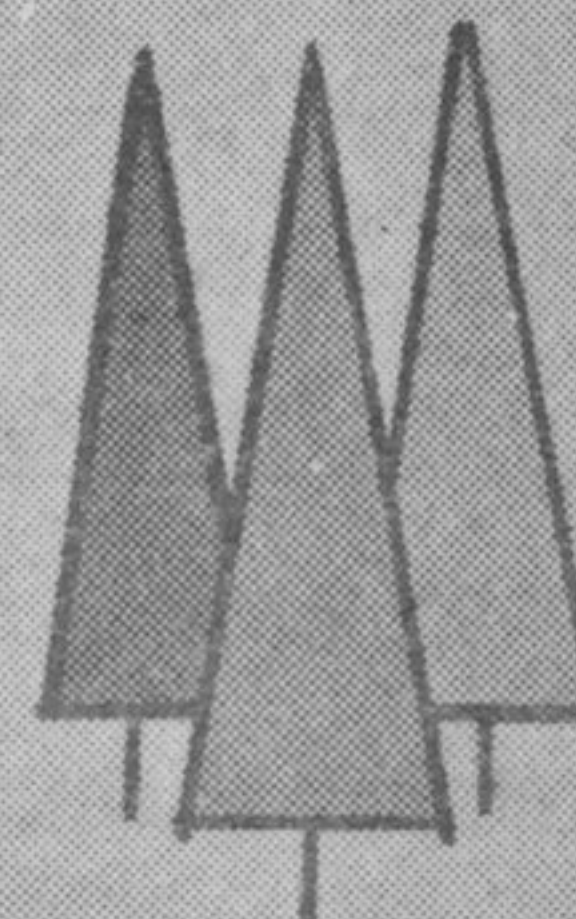

HOSPITAL BOARD MEETING

The McCausland Hospital Board of Governors held a regular meeting on January 21, 1975, in the Schreiber Campus of Lake Superior High School.

The hospital expects some word from Dr. Baldwin within a few weeks in regard to the Functional Programme for the new hospital.

Bernie McCracken announced a meeting to be held with both town councils to discuss alternate methods of financing the local portion of the cost of the new hospital.

The 1975 Hospital Membership Drive will run from February 1st to March 6th. A hospital float is being planned for the Terrace Bay Winter Carnival.

Vic Mazzone reported that the sprinkler system parts had arrived and will be installed beginning on January 22nd. The soil condition survey has been completed and will be turned over to the Development Committee for their review.

Under correspondence, a letter from the Township of Schreiber re-appointing Dorothy Rummery as their representative to the Board. A letter of resignation from V. Mazzone, Administrator, effective February 7, 1975. A letter of resignation from D. Stewart. Resolutions were passed accepting both resignations with regret and with appreciation for past service.

Accounts payable for the month of December 1974 in the total amount of \$28,315.96 were passed for payment.

Heating costs for 1974 were lower than estimated; the hospital will receive a rebate from Pinewood Court.
