# Canadian Transport Commission

**ORONDALE LIMITED PROPOSING TO OPERATE UNDER THE FIRM NAME AND STYLE OF NORONTAIR - APPLICATION FOR AUTHORITY TO OPERATE A COMMERCIAL AIR SERVICE.**

Oron Dale Limited proposing to carry on business under the firm name and style of norOntair has applied for authority to operate a regular Specific Point commercial air service using fixed aircraft in Groups B, C and D to transport persons, goods and mail between the points Sault Ste. Marie, Wawa, Terrace Bay, Thunder Bay and Pickle Lake all in the Province of Ontario.

The authority applied for is sponsored and supported by the Government of Ontario through a proposed contract effective from July 1, 1975 to 22 April, 1978, subject to renewal between Oron Dale Limited and the General Manager of the Ontario Transportation Commission representing the Crown in the Province of Ontario.

Further details of the application will be provided on request to the Committee.

Any person interested may intervene to support, oppose or object to the application in accordance with the Canadian Transport Commission General Rules. The application of service shall be made by declaration under Oath and signed by the Applicant or its Solicitors and the Secretary.
