by Mrs. Nettie Thrower.

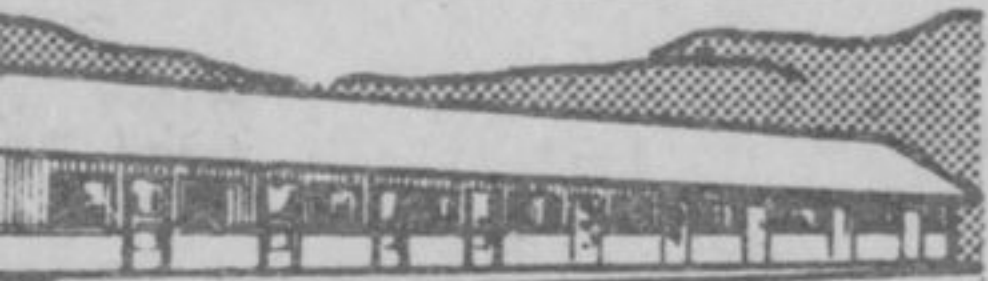
Mrs. Margaret Spillane reported sending a
