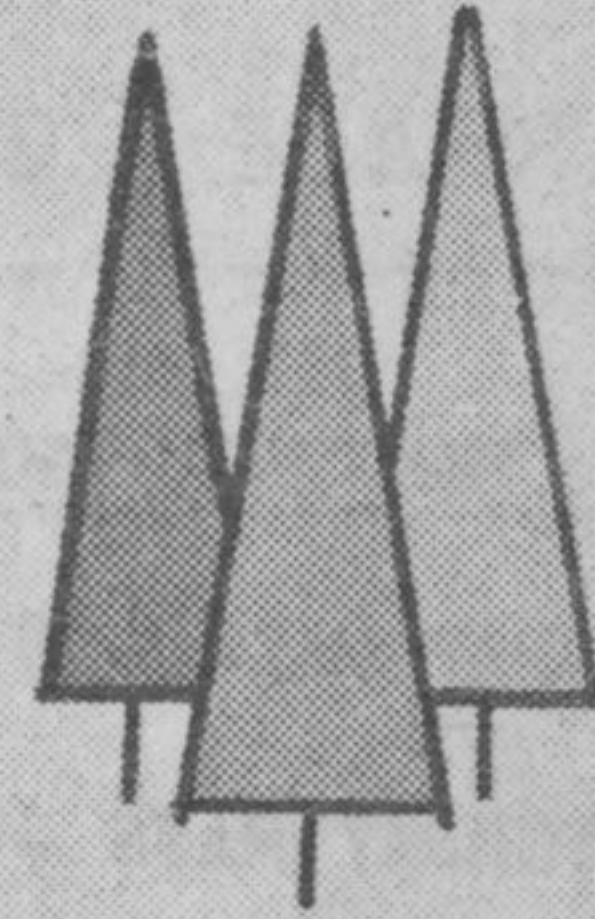

TERRACE BAY COUNCIL QUOTES

February 12th meeting of the Terrace Bay Council. Mrs. Ann Baron and Mrs. Thorpe were present to present the January Board Budget.

Minutes of the previous Council meeting read with a short discussion on snow-clearing from these minutes.

Correspondence included: From the Ministry of Transportation and Communications (roads) re subsidy for 1975; From Transair re application for regional air carrier, which was supported; From Recreation Committee re xerox copier which was granted; From meeting North Western Ontario Municipal Association to be held in Marathon; To Ministry of Environment re K-C mill sewage facility; From local resident re use of public lands; From Township of Marathon re joint sponsorship luncheon; From S.E.I.U. re forthcoming negotiations; From Ministry of Transportation and Communications re Municipal Airport re outlining the 80% subsidy available; From Superior Board of Education re liaison representative - T. Pollard and the Police re January.

Resolutions re elections and term of office completed.

New business the following accounts were paid for payment - Township \$55,910.82; Library \$1,113.28; Recreation \$983.39.

A resolution was passed to submit the annual Expenditures. By-Law 168 was repealed on roads and by-Law 123 was passed on roads and penalties.

Purchase of a powerfeed sewer auger was approved.
