

PUBLIC NOTICE RESIDENTS OF TERRACE BAY BY-LAW 272

part as follows:

prohibiting the obstructing or encumbering of highways and bridges in the Township of Terrace Bay.

Section 476 Subsection 1 of the Municipal Act provides that By-Laws may be enacted by the Councils of Municipalities for the purpose of prohibiting or regulating the obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways and bridges:

WHEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TERRACE BAY ENACTS THE FOLLOWING BY-LAWS:

Any person shall obstruct or encumber any highway or bridge in and under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of Terrace Bay by depositing or placing thereon any matter or thing whatsoever, including, without restricting the generality of the foregoing, any snow, dirt, glass, nails, rubbish or garbage.

Any person convicted of a breach of any provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay, at the discretion of the Court or Judge, a penalty not exceeding the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars exclusive of costs, for each offence, a penalty which shall be recoverable under the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act, 1960, Chapter 387 and amendments.

This By-law was first, second and third times read and passed this 12th day of February 1975.
