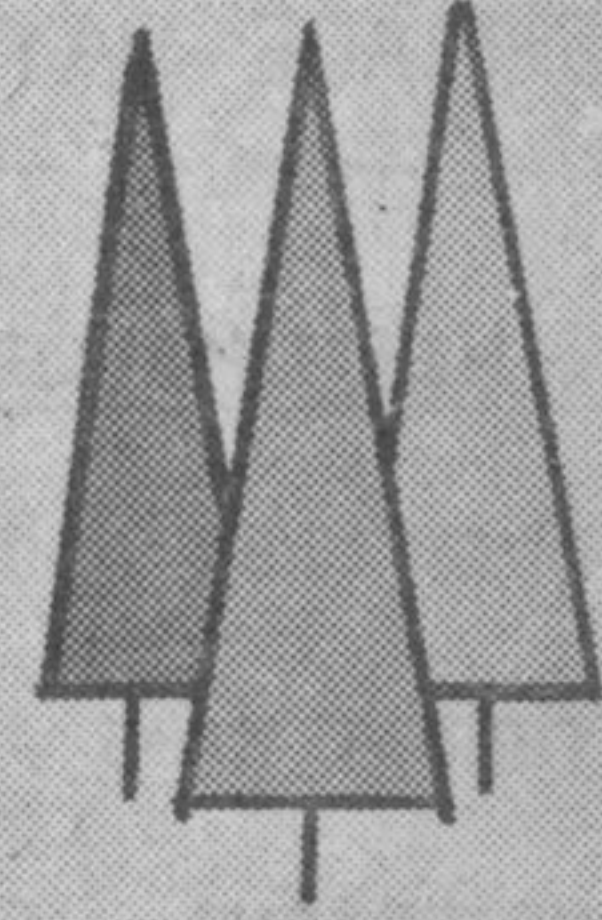

Regular meeting of Terrace Bay Township held Wednesday, March 12th in chambers at the Municipal Office. Councillors Hale, Helmink, Kennedy and Reeve present to begin the meeting with the minutes of the previous regular meeting and minutes of a special meeting held

Correspondence included: From Community and Service re composition of the Board of Home for the Aged stating seven members to be appointed. Councillor Hale is the Mayor's appointee.
