SNOW STATISTIC

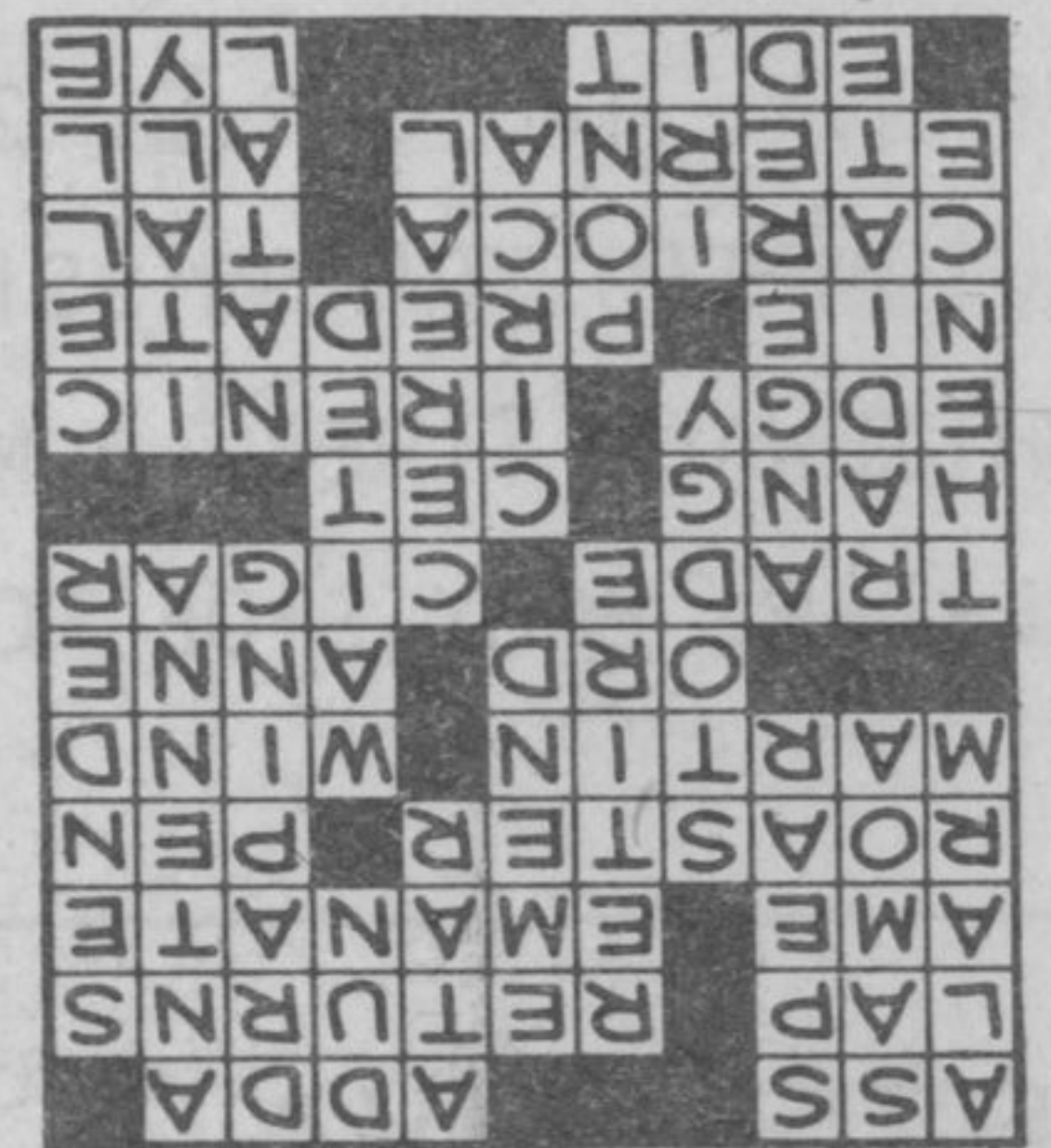
During one 10-inch snowfall it is estimated that over one million flakes may collect on a two foot square.
