Denny and Russell are no novices in walking -- Denny going on a long walk every day, and almost every weekend he and Russell take off on a ten mile hike to some point in the area.

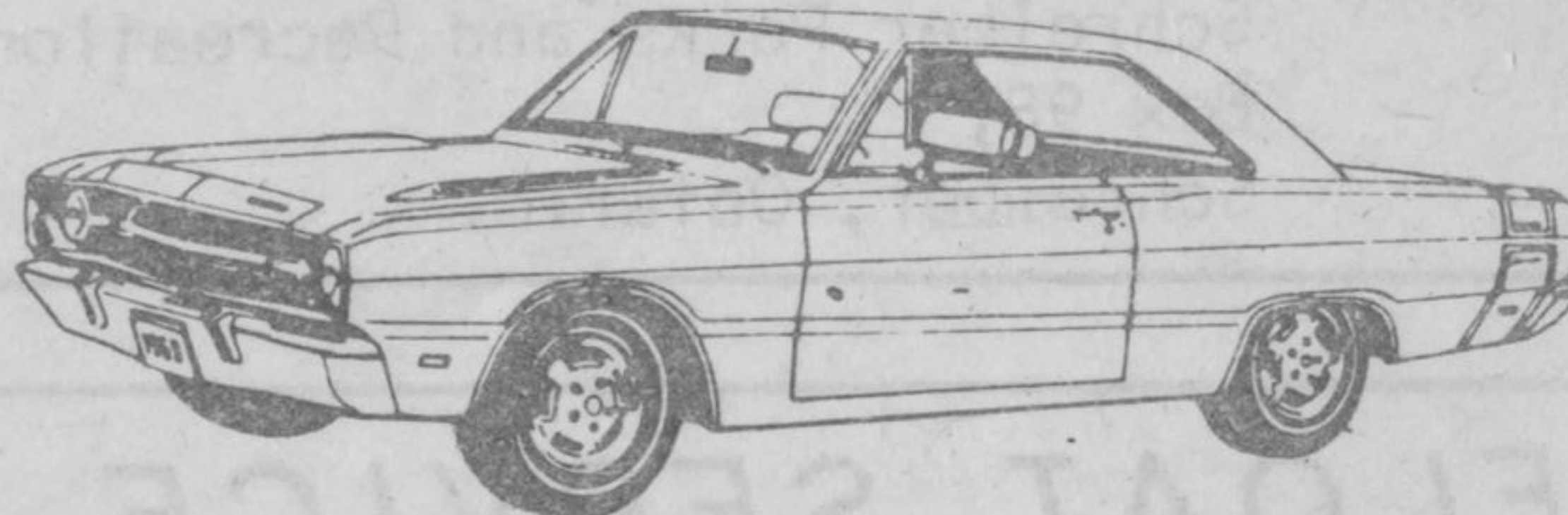
