

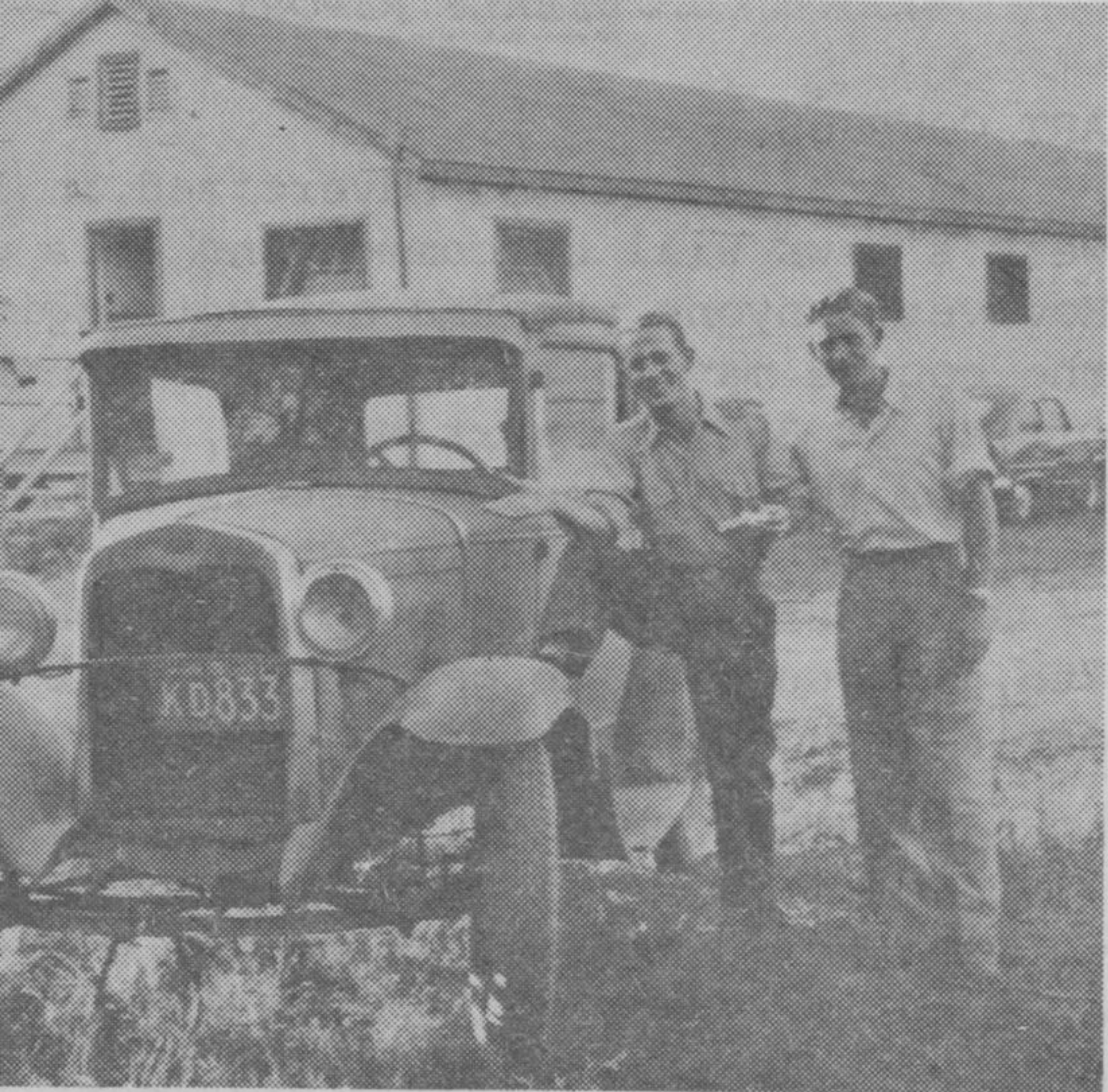
'A TOUCH OF SPRING'
