
The meeting dealt with many questions from the delegates on the operations of the Board. The Administrator submitted a pamphlet outlining expenditures and receipts of the operations in 1974 and also contained data in relation to the area served. There were fortyeight new admissions during 1974, twenty-four to Birchwood Terrace and twenty-four to Pinewood Court. The average age of Residents in the Homes as of December 31st is seventy-eight years. One of the oddities of the area is that there are more males over the age of sixty than females. This is directly opposed to what it is in the rest of Ontario where females over sixty out number males.

The inaugural meeting of the Board will be held in early April with the election of officers as the first item on the agenda.
