## BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING

The minutes of Meeting No. 4/75 held March 29th in Marathon were declared adopted at the Lake Superior Board of Education meeting.

The minutes of the meeting of April 8th of The French Language Advisory Committee were acknowledged as received.

A Petty Cash Fund of \$25.00 will be established for The French Language Advisory Committee, with the Secretary being responsible for the accounting of this fund.

An Honorarium of \$15.00 per month, for twelve months of each year, will be paid to the Secretary of The French Language Advisory Committee, retroactive to March Ist, 1975.

The following policy with respect to employment of personnel for Francais was approved: "A member of The French Language Advisory Committee, appointed by the Committee Chairman, may assist the Principal in the process of interviewing and selection of Francais personnel if the time and location are convenient."

The French Language Advisory Committee will be provided with copies of Agendas for Board Meetings covering topical outline plus any materials relevant to The French Language Advisory Committee.

The minutes of the meeting of April 8th of the Board-Council Liaison Committee were acknowledged as received.

The Disbrusements for the month of March, 1975 totalled \$266,943.13.

Trustees learned of considerable financial savings to be effected through a change in insurance firms.

Effective April 10th, 1975, all Fire, Boiler and Liability Insurance will be placed with Reed Shaw Stenhouse Ltd., Insurance Brokers of Toronto, Ontario.

The Board approved the 1975-76 School Year Calendar and that the Remembrance Day Holiday be observed on November IIth.

The Alexander Campus building of the Marathon Public School will be sold after completion of the addition to the Stevens Avenue Campus; the sale to be conducted in conformance with Ministry of Education procedures.

A Committee for Early School Leaving comprised of seven members: Manitouwadge - K. Mac-Neill, Marathon - M. Dettbarn, Schreiber-Terrace Bay - J. Nugent, the Director of Education, one Trustee from each geographic area and one citizen from each geographic area was established.
