

PUBLIC NOTICE

THUNDER BAY DISTRICT HEALTH COUNCIL has recently been established by the Government of Ontario to plan and coordinate health services in the District of Thunder Bay. The Council is presently engaged in reviewing new health programme proposals for this District for possible inclusion in the Ministry of Health budget for the fiscal year 1976/77.

The major proposals before the Council are for:

Regional Neonatal Intensive Care Unit;

Comprehensive Programme for Coronary Disease, including prevention, acute care treatment, and post-coronary rehabilitation.

The Council wishes to provide opportunity for all interested groups, individuals, or institutions to present briefs giving data and information concerning the need for such programmes for this District. The Council will examine the information provided and, if it is clearly established, may submit a proposal for the inclusion of these programmes in the fiscal estimates for the year 1976/1977.

In addition to information concerning need, the Council requests interested parties to provide the number and kind of resources (staff, space, equipment, dollars) required to implement such programmes. Such information is a required part of any subsequent submission to the Ministry.

The deadline for the submission of briefs is May 14th, 1975.
