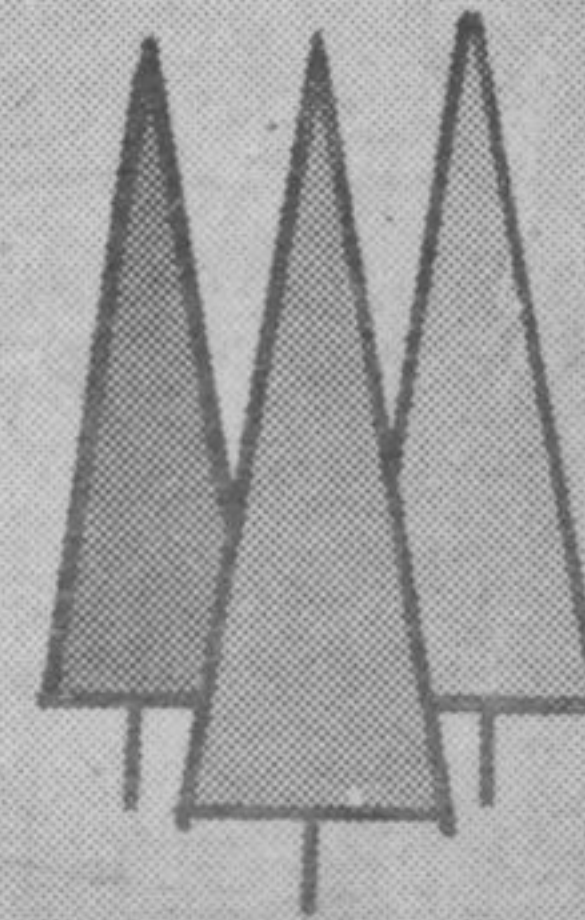

The regular meeting of Terrace Bay Town-
ship Council was held Monday evening, May
12th in Council Chambers.

Jerry Dupas, Recreation Co-Ordinator and
Ollie Chapman, Chairman, presented the Recre-
ation Budget to council.

All councillors were present with Reeve
Bray opening the meeting. The minutes of the
previous meeting were passed.

Correspondence included: An invitation to
attend the Official Opening of the Ontario
Government Building in Thunder Bay, May 14th.

Quetico Centre wrote advising membership
is \$15.00 which was paid.

From the Guides and Brownies requesting
they be allowed to sell carnations and hold
a cookie day. They also offered to take care
of two flower beds in Centennial Park.

A notice of meeting of the Ontario Cabinet
