Have you ever walked the new North Superior Hiking Trail? Be sure you do hike at least part of it to get away from it all for a few hours.

The Ministry of Natural Resources, through the Experience 75 S.W.O.R.D. program, has spon -sored ten local young people to develop the trail.

Under the leadership of Tom McGrath, the group at present, located and cut about eight miles of a hiking trail that will eventually connect Terrace Bay and Schreiber. The completed section of the trail starts at Aguasabon Gorge, follows the river and the Lake Superior shoreline around to Hydro Bay and along the shoreline to Kelly's Harbour. For the greatest part, the trail parallels the shore inside the woods to find safe footing. When safe footing such as a sand or gravel beach is available, the trail runs along the shore. A very scenic lookout has been included in the trail. It is situated on a rocky hill at the east side of Terrace Bay (Hydro Bay). The proposed North Superior hiking trail covers some of the most rugged scenery in Ontario, yet has been designed to follow the easier contours of the land to make hiking enjoyable. Where it is necessary to climb a steep hill, steps have been constructed by the trail crew.

The section of the trail from the Aguasabon Gorge to Hydro Bay can be walked in two hours. We suggest you plan a four or five hour trip, pack a lunch and a camera and view some of the local natural beauty from a different angle.

Preliminary maps of the trail are available at the Ministry of Natural Resources office in Terrace Bay.
