Every petition outlines the following resolution which will be presented at the hearing in Thunder Bay on October 9th. Read it, and if you are in agreement please support the petition by signing your name and address.

Whereas the people of the region of Northern Ontario are deeply distressed about losing one Federal representative with the proposed new boundaries for the Federal ridings:

And Whereas it is time in our history when the region is undergoing its most rapid growth and development and we need every voice in the Parliament of Canada;

And Whereas the proposed new riding has no "sense of community" due to:

- (a) lack of communication, no T.V., radio, newspaper or ground and air transportation links
- (b) difference in geophysical makeup
- (c) vacant land-100 miles in width separating the easterly and westerly sections

Now Therefore be it resolved that the Community of Terrace Bay proclaim the denunciation of the proposed federal electoral districts and petition the Commission to allow the Thunder Bay Riding to remain with the present boundaries.
