It can be very frustrating when you are attempting to reach a police officer by telephone and there is no answer or you have to thumb through a telephone book looking for a number when confronted with an emergency. This need not be if you are familiar with the emergency system for contacting the Ontario Provincial Police.

Simply DIAL "0" and ask the OPERATOR for ZENITH 50,000. Your call is placed through to a detachment where administrative or clerical

staff work 24 hour shifts and your message is given by radio to a unit that is patrolling in your immediate area.

Many persons in Schreiber believe that if no one answers the telephone at the Ontario Provincial Police Detachment, then no one is working and they must wait until morning to receive the assistance required. This is completely erroneous as there is always an officer on duty and a patrol car available to handle any situation.

Zenith 50,000 may be used anywhere in the Province toll free when the police are required or an occurrence needs reporting.
