

DECISION

Ottawa, September 30, 1975

The Canadian Radio-Television Commission announced the following decision effective forthwith.

Decision CRTC 75-435

The Commission renews the broadcasting licences for the following cable television undertakings in Ontario from October 1, 1975 to March 31, 1978 subject to the conditions to be specified therein. This period will enable the Commission to consider renewal of this licence at the same time as that of other cable television licences in the region.

The licences will also be subject to the condition that the licensees own, as a minimum, the local head-end, the amplifiers and the drops to houses and apartment buildings.
