



Where to find a 10¢ pay phone.

The cost of making a local call from some Bell Canada pay phones is increasing to 20 cents. But there are still 10 cent pay phones around. And we'd like to tell you where you can find them.

The 10¢ Pay Phone

Generally, you'll find these phones on municipal sidewalks, in railway and bus stations, in hospitals, nursing homes, rooming houses and churches.

The 20¢ Pay Phone

Pay phones in most other locations, such as hotels, airports and restaurants will go up to 20 cents.

Emergency calling

At the same time, a new service will be added to all outdoor pay phones. What this added service does is enable you to reach the Operator, Directory Assistance and Repair Service without depositing a coin.

From now on, when you're calling from a Bell Canada pay phone, look for the information card above the dial. It clearly tells you whether it's a 10 cent or 20 cent pay phone.
