A total of seventeen occurrences were investigated during the week ending February 8th.

On February 4 a report was received that damage, a break, enter and theft had been committed at a local motel. Two persons

have been charged with wilful damage and two persons charged with two offences of break, enter and theft. Part of the stolen property has been recovered. Damage is in the region of \$500.00 and restitution will be sought.
