BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING: Continued His premature death last week will be lamented by both his teaching colleagues and his students.

Trustee A.S. Gordon, the Chairman of the Maintenance and Property Committee, drew the Board's attention to a brochure recently received from the Ministry of Education impressing upon all Boards the need to conserve energy in schools. It was pointed out that Hydro costs increased by 25% in January and that this could add an additional \$25,000 to the heating and lighting costs of the schools in this division. The Director was, therefore, asked to remind all Principals of the need to co-operate in reducing our consumption of energy in the schools.

The Committee of the Whole Board reports: the resignation of Miss Agnes N. Hutchison, Marathon High School, accepted with regret, effective August 8, 1976, the appointment of Mrs. Diane Kairys to the Manitouwadge High School, at salary according to schedule, for the period January 19, 1976 to June 6, 1976, the appointment of Miss Sheryl E. Zander as part-time secretary at the Manitouwadge High School, at salary according to schedule, effective February 2, 1976, the Maintenance and Property Committee recommended that full time staff should be hired to develop a good preventative maintenance program and to look after the repair and maintenance needs of the houses and apartments as well as the schools under the Board's jurisdiction. A motion was, therefore, approved that competent maintenance staff should be sought through advertising.
