COTTAGE LOT PROGRAM UPDATE: Cont'd sewage disposal systems will be allowed. In other words, the program is designed to allow a person to build a small simple backwoods camp.

At present, remote cottage site selection plans are being prepared for a number of lakes in the Terrace Bay - Schreiber, Marathon and Manitouwadge areas. A number of remote lots will be available by approximately June I5, 1976.

Regular summer resort lots in the proposed subdivisions on Santoy and Wabikoba Lakes will probably be available this Fall.


