## INFORMATION ONTARIO

The following information will be of interest to Senior Citizens age 65 or over and who are residents of Ontario.

The question which is most commonly asked is: what is a Senior Citizens Privilege Card and what is a Drug Card. This card is one and the same and is light blue in colour. It may or may not have a number at the bottom.

As a Privilege Card, it allows the holder to enjoy free of charge or at reduced rates, services and facilities such as entering Ontario Provincial Parks, Historical and Cultural Sites, etc.

Some businesses offer discounts for Senior Citizens. As well, some transit systems have Senior Citizens Rates. (Some transit systems still require that you use a specific card issued by them.)

As a Drug Card, the drug benefit provides, free of charge, only the more than 1,500 drugs listed in Ontario's Drug Benefit Formulary. The formulary does not list all drugs available, Cont'd pg. 3....
