The offices should be regular recipients of material issued by the Ministry. These offices are easily accessible to a large segment of Northwestern Ontario's population, and their easy access through telex to Queen's Park makes them a natural conduit for contact with the area".

This is the purpose of Northern Affairs.

To provide information to the residents of
Northern Ontario. The offices of Northern Affairs were established in 1970, with the Marathon office opening in November. The calendar year 1971 produced 1,332 transactions, while March 1976 alone produced 1,033, compared with February totalling 1,211 transactions.

The workload of Northern Affairs has changed considerably as more government ministries and agencies utilize us to diseminate their information, and request our services. Some of the services provided by this office include; telephone answering services, booking appointments for the driver examiner, Federal Development Bank, Northern Ontario Development Corporation, registering applicants for Confederation College Courses, supervising industrial training examinations, representing the Ministry of Labour re employment standards, accepting consumer protection complaints, issuing fire permits, as well as, distributing information and pamphlets.

Approximately 20% of the workload consists of federal enquiries, such as U.I.C., C.P.P., O.A.S., and Manpower.


