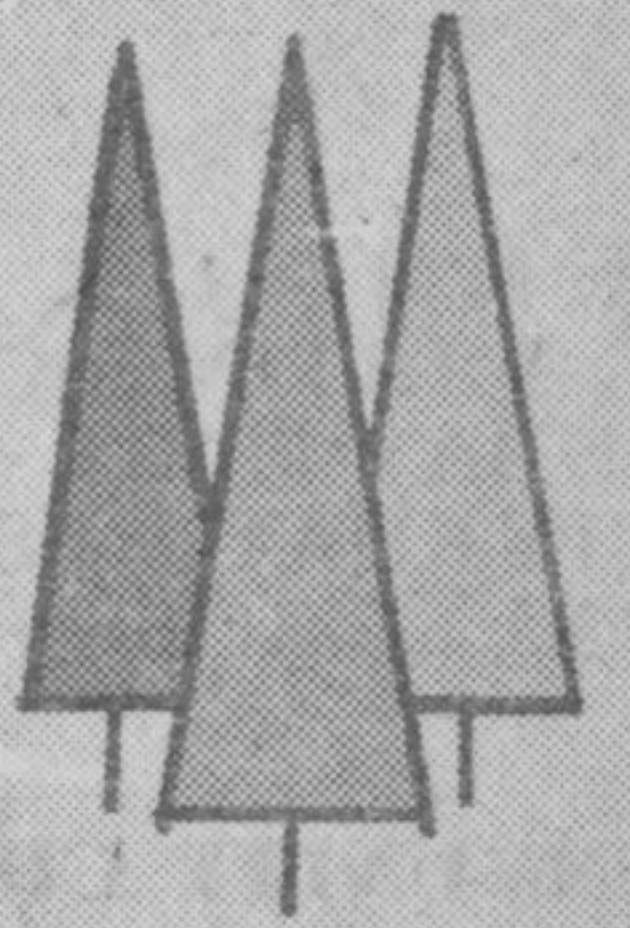

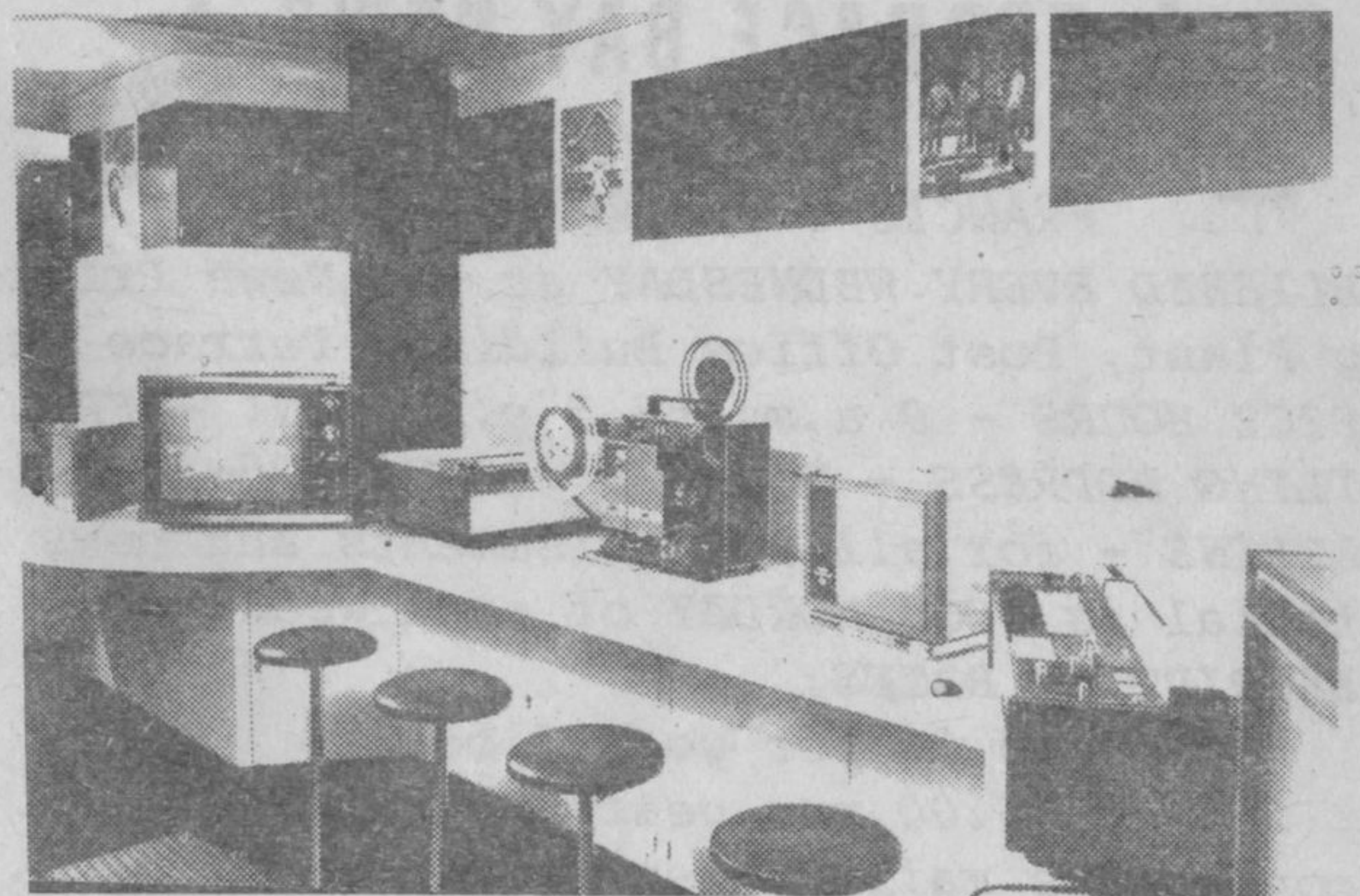
## SPORTS TRAVELCADE COMING TO TERRACE BAY
