TERRACE BAY DISTRICT COTTAGING PROGRAM

On July 17th a public draw was held at the Terrace Bay High School for the disposition of twenty-one remote sites. The draw was attended by approximately seventy eligible applicants, which indicates a high interest in this type of recreational land use. District staff are presently engaged in preparing plans for a number of remote cottage lots, in the Manitouwadge area, which will be made available this fall. We also intend to make additional remote lots available in the North Shore area next spring.

Planning for the proposed summer resort subdivisions on Santoy Lake and Wabiloba Lake is progressing well. If boundary surveys are carried on time, we will be making these lots available in the fall by public draw. The dates for the public draw will be advertised in the local newspapers. For further information on our cottaging program please contact the Lands and Parks Supervisor at Terrace Bay or the Fire Control Supervisor at Manitouwadge.
