CHANGES IN ONTARIO HUNTING LICENCES

Beginning in 1976, Ontario licence issuers will be requesting the Social Insurance Number of each person who purchases a hunting licence.

Past experience has shown that the Ontario Driver's Licence Number, previously requested, was a bit awkward to record. As well, only 70% of Ontario hunters have a driver's licence.

The Social Insurance Number has only nine digits making it easier to record and remember. More than 90% of Ontario's hunters presently have such a number. Since the Social Insurance Number is recorded at birth every person has a number on file and may receive it on application. Application forms are available at post Offices, Manpower Centres, etc.

There will be a one or two year "initial" period when hunters will be advised to get their Social Insurance Numbers if they do not have them. After the initial period, Ontario hunting licences will not be issued unless the hunter's Social Insurance Number is available.
