It also develops from a substantial difference in the seeing ability of the two eyes. If left untreated, this condition can lead to a loss of sight which cannot be restored."

"Treatment may include patching, glasses or in some cases, surgery."

Some tell-tale symptoms are frequent rubbing of the eyes, shutting or covering one eye, bumping into objects on one side or an eye that isn't straight.

Arrange for a complete eye examination on the Mobile Eye Care Unit if you suspect that your child has either of these conditions. An appointment with the ophthalmologist can be made by phoning 825-3840.

- DRIVERS TO STOP FOR SCHOOL BUSES

With school opening, and 600,000 Ontario school children getting ready to ride school buses, drivers should remember they must stop for school buses, says Minister of Trasportation and Communications James Snow.

This year it is also mandatory to stop for school crossing guards guiding school child-ren across the road. Previously, it was a matter of safety and courtesy, with no penalty.

The school bus stopping law, under Section 120 of The Highway Traffic Act, requires traffic travelling in both directions to halt when a stopped school bus flashes its alternating red signal lights, regardless of the posted speed limit.

Traffic may not proceed until the school bus resumes motion or its red lights - at the front and rear of the bus - stop flashing.

Failure to stop for a school bus with its alternating red signal lights flashing carries a penalty of four demerit points and a Maximum fine of \$100.00
