

TERRACE BAY POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT

Police investigated 24 occurrences during the week of October 3rd to 9th.

During the early evening hours of October 3/76 police apprehended and charged a Schreiber resident with Impaired Driving and Driving Disqualified.

The theft of a portable tape deck player was reported on October 5/76 by a resident. This matter is presently under investigation.

On October 7th Police investigated an alleged threatening charge. As a result of this investigation a local resident has been charged with possession of a weapon dangerous to the public peace.

During routine patrol one local resident was charged with having liquor in other than his residence, while another was charged with having no insurance upon his motor vehicle.

On October 8th a North Bay resident was charged with doing 80 m.p.h. in a 55 m.p.h zone. During routine patrol a car operated by Thunder Bay youths was checked, subsequently a quantity of drugs and liquor was siezed. Charges for possession of Narcotics and liquor have been laid.
