Prime Minister Trudeau has announced the ap -pointment of Keith Penner, M.P. (Liberal, Thunder Bay) as Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs. In his new position, Mr. Penner will be assisting the Honourable Warren Allmand in the administration of a wide-ranging department which includes Indian and Eskimo Affairs, Parks Canada, Historic Sites and Northern Development, involving such controversial issues as the Mac-Kenzie Valley pipeline inquiry.

Prior to his recent appointment, Keith Penner served as Parliamentary Secretary to the Honourable C.M. Drury in the Ministry of Science and Technology. In his eight year career in The House of Commons, Mr. Penner has also been Chairman of the Regional Development Committee and Assistant Deputy Speaker.
