the same credit qualifications and property
or earnings would receive credit.

2. An unmarried woman shall be granted credit if her credit qualifications, property or earnings would receive credit.

Credit is a form of borrowing, It is a way of obtaining goods, services, or money in exchange for a promise to pay for them at some future time.

Using credit has both advantages and disadvantages.
