The Council of the Township of Schreiber, as required by the Ontario Municipal Board, under By-Law 591 has authorized that the following question be submitted to the electors of the Township of Schreiber, at the next regular municipal election to be held on December 6, 1976.

**ARE YOU IN FAVOUR OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCHREIBER CONSTRUCTING A NEW ARENA, AND THE ISSUING OF DEBENTURES IF NECESSARY?**

All persons who are eligible to vote under Section 12 or 13 of the Municipal Elections Act, and is the owner of land assessed in the Municipality, or the tenant of land assessed in the Municipality, under a lease which extends for the time of the debt created, and is covenanted to pay the taxes on the land thereof, is eligible to vote on the question.
