One snowmobile operator was charged with the careless operation of his motorized Isnow vehicle.

Section 13-1 of the motorized snow vehicles act reads as follows - No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle at a greater rate of speed than, (a) 15 miles per hour, (1) on a highway where the speed limit established pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act is 30 miles per hour or less, or (11) in any public park or exhibition grounds; or

(b) 30 miles per hour, (1) on any highway which is open to motor vehicle traffic, where the speed limit established pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act is greater than 30 miles per hour, or (11) on a public trail.
