

TERRACE BAY POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT

The Terrace Bay Police Department was called to investigate twenty-two occurrences during the period January 1 to January 9, 1977.

On January 4, Police were called upon to attend at the arena during the Nip Rock - Schreiber Junior hockey game. Several fans had been involved in fights during the game and were evicted. As a result the hockey game was called with four minutes remaining.

One motorist was charged with not having a valid licence plate on his vehicle.

Two snowmobile operators were checked and cautioned about operation of their vehicles.

One accident was investigated resulting in damage of approximately \$800.00.

One motorist was charged with failing to afford reasonable opportunity to avoid a collision.

Two persons were charged with having liquor readily available in their vehicles.

One motorist was charged with not having insurance for his vehicle.

One motorist was charged with failing to register his motor vehicle.

One snowmobile operator was charged with the careless operation of his motorized snow vehicle.

Section 13-1 of the motorized snow vehicles act reads as follows - No person shall drive a motorized snow vehicle at a greater rate of speed than, (a) 15 miles per hour, (1) on a highway where the speed limit established pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act is 30 miles per hour or less, or (11) in any public park or exhibition grounds; or (b) 30 miles per hour, (1) on any highway which is open to motor vehicle traffic, where the speed limit established pursuant to the Highway Traffic Act is greater than 30 miles per hour, or (11) on a public trail.

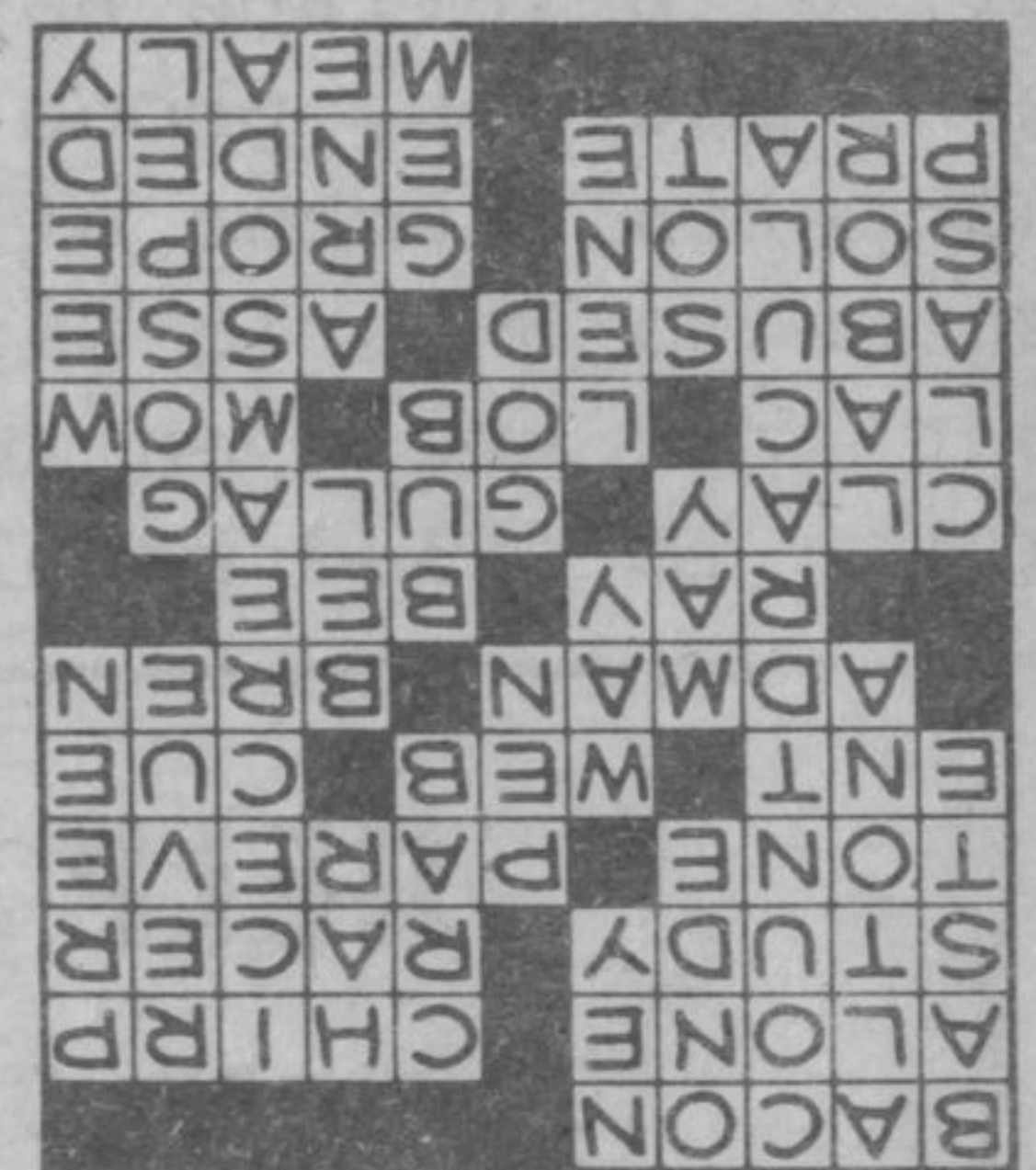
